LifeLine/ChildLine Namibia with funding from the Roger Federer Foundation is implementing a School Readiness program. The program is being implemented in 7 regions (Karas, Erongo, Hardap, Otjozondjupa, Kavango West, Kavango East, and Zambezi Regions). The overall goal of the initiative is to secure a good start in formal education by enhancing the capacity of ECD educators and pre-primary teachers through a tablet based Early Learning Kiosk. The initiative is being implemented in 676 pre-primary facilities country wide through facilitation and supportive tools in encouraging and empowering parents to engage in their children's pre school education.

LifeLine/ChildLine Namibia is also focused on the empowerment of women and girls. LifeLine/ChildLine' was awarded the Gender is my Agenda award in 2018 at a state banquet due to the strong Gender Agenda to promote Gender Equality in the country. The Gender Department implements projects with the overall goal of promoting Gender Equality and address harmful Gender norms in a Gender transformative manner. These projects include:

MALE ENGAGE NAMIBIA- A network comprising of 16 different partners from CSO's, Government and Development Partners. The goal of this initiative is to strengthen collaboration among different stakeholders to scale efforts to work with men and boys to address GBV, HIV and to promote Sexual Reproductive Health Rights as well as promote Gender Equality in Namibia.

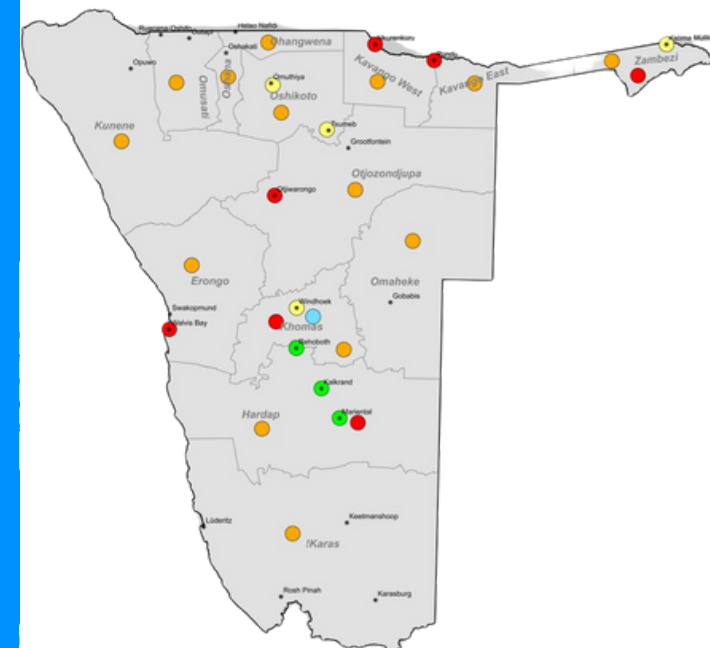

COUNSELLING @LLCL

LifeLine/ChildLine Namibia currently runs the only national helpline-based counselling service in Namibia. In addition to the helpline, the counselling centre also offers face to face counselling services as well as school outreach programmes. The 116 Child Helpline provides toll free services focused on assisting children with difficulties, dealing with emotional distress, abuse(all types), educational problems etc.



The 106 Gender-Based Violence Helpline aims to assist those in need of help when found in a GBV-related situation or any other dangerous situations such as suicide. The Counselling Centre has staff comprising of social workers, social work interns, psychology students, and lay counsellors. The crisis line was established in 1980, and still in existence. The lines are accessible to all Namibians free of charge. The Counselling Centre also has a SMS line which is an alternative platform which individuals can use to access counselling services.

LifeLine/ChildLine Namibia is a registered Child Protection Agency with designated social workers. Child Protection services are dedicated to protecting young people and vulnerable children through provision of services to strengthen child protection system and to promote positive social norms in all contexts. This is done to prevent and respond to child abuse to ensure improved outcomes for vulnerable children and families.

LifeLine/ChildLine collaborates with various stakeholders and partners to achieve this noble goal.

The Child protection charter of LL/CL contributes to the child protection advocacy through the following platforms; Namibia Child Rights Network, Namibia Integrated Early Childhood Development Committee, Namibia Coordination Committee on HIV/AIDS, Tuberculosis- and Malaria, The permanent Task Force of Children, Child protection.
